FAMILY AND COMMUNITY ISSUES DIRECTOR:

- 1. Is a member of the County Education Committee, of which the First Vice President is chairman
- 2. Is encouraged to initiate her/his own original ideas, in addition to the IAHCE Programs, or to select a combination of areas of concern that will best fit the needs of the county.
- 3. Prepare IAHCE Report Form (s) using programs you had in this category during the current year. Forms will be found in this Guidebook. Mail completed forms by January 31, to the IAHCE Family and Community Issues Director, whose name and address is listed on page 1 of this Guidebook.
- 4. Is encouraged to celebrate "HCE Great American Family Week" and submit ONE family for the Illinois Great American Family Award. The application for this award can be found in this Guidebook. It is due on January 31.

Suggested Programs:

FAMILY LIVING

Objectives: To provide experiences that will improve the quality of family members and/or family unit, strengthen and promote the growth and development of family members and/or family unit, and provide opportunities to promote and encourage energy conservation and efficient use of natural resources.

Suggested Actions:

- 1. Action plan to increase young family membership (recruitment).
- 2. "Family Day" program to include spouse and children in an educational situation.
- 3. Weekly family night
- 4. "Make a Difference Day" as part of IAHCE Month or IAHCE Week.
- 5. Personal and/or home safety.
- 6. Child, adult or elder abuse programs.
- 7. Vehicle and/or farm implement safety.
- 8. Avoidance of con artists or scams.
- 9. Energy efficient applications for the home.

HEALTH, FOOD & NUTRITION

<u>Objective</u>: To educate members and community about benefits of proper health and nutrition, food handling and preparation techniques and healthy lifestyle choices.

Suggested Actions:

- 1. Exercise programs for health and fitness (charity walks).
- 2. American Heart Association programs to educate others about heart disease and symptoms.
- 3. Organ and Tissue donation programs.
- 4. Blood Drives
- 5. In collaboration with local hospitals and/or health departments, provide breast cancer awareness and mammogram information.
- 6. Nutrition programs to educate others about reading nutrition labels and making healthy food choices.
- 7. Programs to educate others about fitness programs and/or online applications to track weight loss, exercise and calorie intake.

CITIZENSHIP

Objective: To identify community and environmental needs and conduct programs to fill these needs.

Suggested Activities:

- 1. Inform the public of the impact and importance of "Citizens' Power" in shaping the destiny of the community and nation.
- 2. Literacy programs for youth, adults and elderly with vision impairment.
- 3. Assistance programs for persons with chronic diseases/disabilities.
- 4. Drug and alcohol abuse programs.
- 5. Family and community values workshops.
- 6. Proper waste handling and waste management.
- 7. Adopt-a-Highway program.
- 8. Reduce-Reuse-Recycle (3 R's) program.
- 9. Community gardens.
- 10. Respect and handling of the American Flag.
- 11. Conservation of renewable resources (fuel, forest products, water, etc.).
